The Gozo Action Group Foundation

- The GAGF was founded in 2009.
- Members from the Private Sectors:
 - Gozo Business Chambers
 - Gozo NGOs Associations
 - Gozo Tourism Association
 - Gozo Confederations of Agriculture & Fisheries
 - Others
- Members from the Public Sector
 - All of the 14 Gozitan Local Councils











The Gozo Action Group Foundation

- The GAGF is directed by a Decision Committee consisting of 7 members: 3 from the Public Sector and 4 from the Private Sector.
- The aim of the GAGF is to create more opportunities for NGOs, Local Councils, and other entities.
- The GAGF encourages collaborative initiatives and innovative projects that enhance the quality
 of life in Gozo for all.
- The GAGF has been able to continuously reach its aim through the ongoing opportunity of administering the EU Funded LEADER Programme in the Gozo Region.











History of the L.E.A.D.E.R. Programme

- Established in 1991, financed by the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD).
- Introduced locally in the 2007-2013 Rural Development Programme (RDP).
- Operates with a bottom-up approach which includes stakeholder from various sectors.
- Aims to:
 - Support small-scale community projects
 - o Increase capacity of local rural communities and business networks
 - Encourage innovation and cooperation to address local development objectives
- These aims are addressed through the Local Development Strategy and are tailored to each territory.
- Malta consists of 3 territories and has 3 LAG's. Each LAG manages it's respecitive territory according to their LDS.
- The LAG's are: GAL Majjistral Foundation, the GAL Xlokk Foundation and the Gozo Action Group Foundation











Why the Fourth Call under GAG4?

- Rural Agricultural Fund for Rural Development 2014 2020
- Original budget under M19.2: €1,474,440
- Additional Funding:
 - Due to Covid-19 pandemic (programme was extended till 2025), i.e. Rural Agricultural Fund for Rural Development 2014 2022
 - savings on projects
 - irregularities
- Original budget + Additional Funding under M19.2: €2,636,680
- Last Additional Funding: €240,000











General and Specific Objectives of the measure 4 for Gozo

- 'New Economy Activities': The action is expected to provide lifestyle attractions to young people and young families by focusing on amenities and activities associated with the new economy', with potential spin-off effects on employment generation;
- 'Climate and Environment': Investment and activities promoted through this action will need to deliver improvements in environmental and climate performance, due to the importance of these factors for a healthy lifestyle of young persons and families.











General and Specific Objectives of the measure 4 for Gozo

- 'Gozo Lifestyle': The main focus of this action is the preservation, valorization and evolution of the Gozitan lifestyle through the retention and attraction of a younger population.
- 'Cultural Heritage': The action is expected to improve on cultural heritage assets as a means to improve the lifestyle for young persons and young families
- 'Partnership Approach': The action must involve collaboration between Local Councils, NGOs and business operators











Type of Operations

- The action will provide resources to:
 - Improve the attractiveness of Gozo for **young persons and young families** through the creation of hard and soft support infrastructures;
 - Enhance the involvement of Local Councils, NGOs and business operators in improving the quality of life and the environment in Gozo for **young persons and families**.











Type of Support

• Investments by NGOs, Local Councils, and/or business operators, with a direct interest in young persons and young families, in equipment and in providing new and or/extended services which is specifically required for their specialized activities (e.g. childcare, sports, cultural, educational activities, community entertainment activities compatible with the Gozitan lifestyle), capacity-building in undertaking innovative and/or extended activities of direct interest to young persons and young families











Eligible Investment supported:

• Investment in equipment by NGOs, Local Councils and Business Operators, up to 100% of budget

 Capacity-building by NGOs including running costs of offering services, up to 15% of budget



Eligible Beneficiaries:

- Applications are accepted from entities regularly operating or providing a service within the geographic area covered by the GAGF.
- Applicants can be Local Councils, NGOs and business operators.
- Each application must consist of **any three (3) entities**, from the aforementioned categories. The applicant has to co-operate with at least two other partners. A lead partner should also be appointed who shall be considered as the project applicant. The application shall clearly specify the role to be played by the applicant and the project partners.
- Any one entity (whether main beneficiary and/or partner) can apply under one or more of the measures, but <u>cannot</u> participate under different/competing applications within the same measures, unless the entity submits the **Final Payment Declaration** as submitted to **ARPA**.











Eligible Beneficiaries:

- It is important to note that:
 - Private undertakings where eligible, are to be limited to SME's. Large firms (as per Eurostat definition), are excluded.
 - NGOs refer to entities that are enrolled and fully compliant with the Voluntary Organisations Act and its subsidiary legislation 492.02 (Annual Returns and Annual Accounts) Regulations 2012.
 - The applicant has to be a member of the decision board/unit/committee (or is the legal representative) of the beneficiary/applicant organizing.











Indicators and Targets (including past calls)

Number of Local Councils (municipalities) offering new and improved amenities for young persons and families:	8
Number of businesses offering new and improved services for young persons and families:	23
Number of NGOs offering new and improved services for young persons and families:	21











Aid Intensity

- For the scope of this call, beneficiaries will receive 80% of the total eligible project costs as public funds with the other 20% coming as a private contribution;
- The Measure Budget (Total Public Expenditure) is €240,000
- The minimum grant support per project is capped at €40,000
- The maximum grant support per project is capped at €120,000











Important Points:

- Projects have to completed within a limited timeframe.
- All project must be implemented by <u>MAY 2025</u>.
- The <u>COMPETITIVE</u> selection process will be undertaken by the Project Selection Committee (PSC).

i. the degree of synergy between infrastructures developed and services proposed.	15 points
5. Overall quality of the project proposal.	5 points
6. Implementation readiness.	5 points
7. Number of partners in proposed project (3 points per partner up to a maximum of 10 points)	10 points
TOTAL:	100 points

- 4 applications Total €340,000
- Project 004 applied for €100,000, only €50,000 is available
- Project 0001 is on the reserve list due to budget constraints



- Private Bodies are to follow MA PA EAFRD Circular 01/2021
- Advance payment of up to 50% of the total eligible cost, beneficiary will have to coordinate with ARPA
- Interim payments are possible
